"A moonless night" tells the story of three men who arrive, in New Year's eve, to a small lost town in the countryside of Uruguay where they will have the opportunity to twist their fate.

It is a film about love, missed opportunities and the passage of time.

ABOUT THE FILM

A moonless night is a co-production of Raindogs Cine from Uruguay and Cine El Calefón from Argentina. The film was supported by the Uruguayan Film Institute (ICAU), the Argentinean Film Institute (INCAA), the Ibermedia Program, Montevideo Socio Audiovisual and the Government of the Province of Córdoba.

SYNOPSIS

During New Year's Eve, three lonely characters travel to a small town lost in the Uruguayan countryside. Cesar, a divorced man, arrives to the town where he will have dinner with his ex-wife's new family to win back his little daughter's love. Antonio, a small-time magician, is trying to get to town to perform his routine at the community center, but his car breaks down. Stranded in the middle of the deserted road he meets Laura, a woman working at the toll station. Miguel, a performer, prepares his musical return to sing at the community center's New Year party. Following these paths, the characters will have a chance to turn around their destiny.

STATMENT DIRECTOR

The turning of the page in calendars re-ignite the illusion that things can change: a new cycle apparently begins. "A moonless night" seeks to convey this New Year's pseudofestive mood through its rusty characters, with a rough tenderness, who find in the New Year's eve, a new opportunity to twist their fates.

DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY GERMÁN TEJEIRA | MONTEVIDEO, 1982

In 1999, Germán participated in a workshop organized by the Sundance Institute in Montevideo and in a filmmaking workshop by Fernando "Pino" Solanas. In 2001, he joined the ECU (Uruguay Film School), from which he graduated in 2004 with majors in film directing and cinematography.

In 2006 Germán received a grant from Unión Latina to take part of a scriptwriting and editing workshop dictated by Giorgio Arlorio and Roberto Perpignani at the Scuola Nazionale di Cinema and the Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia in Rome, Italy.

In 2007, Germán received a grant from Ibermedia to participate in a creative production and script editing workshop in Santiago, Chile; and in 2008 his project "A moonless night" was selected to participate in the "Iberoamerican Film Project Development Course" in Madrid, Spain. Germán's project was mentored by Ines Paris and Alicia Luna.

Between 2009 and 2012 Germán served as executive producer, co-writer and co-editor of the animated feature film "Anina", directed by Alfredo Soderguit, which premiered in 2013 at the Berlin International Film Festival and was exhibited at several international festivals, including the 2013 San Sebastián International Film Festival. Anina received several recognitions and awards, including the audience awards at Anima Mundi (Brazil) and at the 2013 Buenos Aires Independent Film Festival. "Anina" has also been selected to represent Uruguay at the 2014 Goya Awards in Spain and the 2014 Academy Awards in the USA. In Uruguay, Anina was the Uruguayan film most watched in 2013.

In 2013 Germán shot his directorial debut, "A moonless night", premiered in 2014 at the San Sebastián International Film Festival (In the "New Directors" competitive section). "A moonless night" has recently received the Golden Eye award as best international feature film at the 10th Zurich Film Festival.¹

Germán is also scriptwriter and co-director of the film "Wooden eyes" (co-directed with Roberto Suárez), currently in post-production.

In 2014, Germán served as executive producer of the documentary film "Caddies", directed by Pablo Accuosto, which will be aired in 22 public television channels in Latin America.

Germán is executive producer and co-scriptwriter of the feature documentary "Suspiciously Russians", directed by Julián Goyoaga - currently in production.

In November 2013 Germán was mentioned by Variety as one of "Latin America rising starts in film production."²

PRODUCER'S BIOGRAPHY JULIÁN GOYOAGA | MONTEVIDEO, 1970

Director, writer, producer and editor, Julián graduated from the Escuela de Cine del Uruguay (ECU, Uruguay Film School) in 2005. He has written and directed several short films and documentaries as well as serving as executive producer and film editor in other people's projects.

Together with Germán Tejeira, Julián co-founded the Raindogs Cine production company in order to develop and promote animated, fiction and documentary projects.

In 2013, Raindogs Cine's first feature, the animated film "Anina" (by Alfredo Soderguit) was released, which Julián co-wrote, co-edited and co-produced.

In early 2013 Germán Tejeira shoot his debut feature film "A moonless night", for which Julián is the executive producer and editor. In late 2013 Julián also began shooting "Roslik: Suspiciously Russians", his debut documentary film, which combines traditional documentary shooting with animated sequences.

In 2009 Julián co-edited Enrique Buchichio's debut feature film "Leo's room", which premiered at the 2009 San Sebastian International Film Festival.

Julián's previous work in short films (as director, writer and editor) was honored with several awards, including: Best National Short Film and Best Screenplay in La Pedrera Short Film Festival for his film "Tanto tiempo" ("Long time no see") (2006) and Best National Short Film for "Matrioshka" (2008), which Julián co-directed and co-wrote.

Julián's short film "El hombre muerto" ("Dead man") premiered at the Rotterdam International Film Festival 2009 and received special mentions at the 18th Biarritz Film Festival and the FENSACOR Film Festival in Santiago, Chile, in addition to winning four awards at La Pedrera Short Film Festival, including Best Fiction Film and Best Directing.

Between 2009 and 2011 Julián served on the board of the Film Producers and Directors Association in Uruguay (ASOPROD).

Since 2012 he teaches editing at the ECU. In addition, in 2010 Julián co-ordinated the DocMontevideo Meetings, a market space for documentary projects producers and sales agents or decision makers of Latin America television companies.

Julián is currently developing his first fiction feature film as director, "Koch variations".
